Annual Survey of Substance Use, Mental Health, and Factors Related to School Success

Be prepared!

- Know if the school corporation has registered for the upcoming survey.
- Determine who would be the best person at the school to discuss the INYS.
- Seek other community and school supports to encourage school personnel's interest.
- Understand and be comfortable discussing the benefits of INYS participation with the school.
- Be ready to share specific tasks you will do to support the school's participation (e.g., assisting with survey administration, interpreting results).
- Contact the INYS coordinator (or your project officer) with any remaining questions or concerns.

Convenient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only takes 30 minutes to complete • Can administer the survey any date, late January through early April
Customizable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can add up to 15 additional questions of your choosing
Confidential	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student responses are confidential • Only your school corporation will have access to your results
Valuable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gathers local data necessary for grant writing, program improvement, and strategic planning
Believable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-report data is screened for inconsistencies and dishonest responses are excluded from analysis
