

Do you want to get a FREE measurement of your students' substance use, academic risk factors, and social well-being? You can have it with the Indiana Youth Survey (INYS)! During the spring semester of the 2016-2017 school year, Indiana schools can conduct the INYS with 6th-12th grade students.

### WHAT IS THE INYS?

- An annual self-reported adolescent survey with topics such as tobacco, alcohol, and other drug use; mental health; gambling; and risk and protective factors related to student success.
- All materials are provided (including survey booklets, detailed instructions, even shipping for those choosing the paper option).
- Available in paper or online formats.
- Takes approximately 30 minutes to administer.
- Schools can add up to 15 additional questions.

### WHAT DO SCHOOLS GET?

- A free school corporation report combining student responses by grade level.
- Publicly available statewide results for local comparison.
- Training and technical assistance to help schools interpret and use the data.
- Trend reports for school corporations that participate over time.
